  - Motion to accept the minutes from last meeting- **Approved**
  - Chairperson report- Sue Alterman
- Open House will be March 24th at 6:00pm. Volunteers to make this event a success are needed.
- Emily Curtis gave the Treasurer's report. There is a total of \$2768.38 in the PAC account after deposits of \$1485.86 and expenses of \$167.44. Check #198 for \$1215.89 was ratified. Motion to accept the budget report- **Approved**
  - GV Women's Choir performance led by Janie Prucha
  - Presentation from the Electives Department-Janie Prucha
- GV offers a wide array of Fine Arts, Practical Arts and Performing Arts Elective, including Art, Silk Screen, Print Shop, Theater, Choir, Video Production, Band, Foods, ASB, Dance, Sports Broadcasting, Web Design and Computer Graphics. There are also Career Pathways in Culinary and video that partner with C.O.C.
- DAC Report- Colleen Villani: Kathy Hunter spoke about safety in regards to cell phone use and student conduct. Inappropriate behaviors can have serious legal consequences.
  - PAC Report- Suzy Holmes: Updates to school sites include painting and stadium updates, and the construction of a two-story building at Sierra Vista.
  - Presentation from Captain Theodore Flestado to recognize two GV students who have signed on to the U.S. Army. The recruiting office donated \$1,000 to GV sports programs. Private Tyler Schumann and Carla Torres were sworn in and recognized for their commitment.
  - Charter College presentation- Mina Creswell: Information about these degree and certificate programs can be found online. Charter College offers programs in Health Care, Information Technologies, Criminal Justice, Business and Hospitality.
  - Connecting to Success- Yvett Landeros: C to S will be offered on 11/13 to 11th grade students in conjunction with local businesses to educate and encourage students to look for jobs locally. Workshops will be offered in the areas of image, ethics and money smarts.
  - Student Plan for Student Achievement- Yvett Landeros: This plan includes goals to increase in five areas: 1. Career Tech, 2. Literacy, 3. Proficiency in Math Concepts, 4. Parent Involvement, 5. CAHSEE Pass Rate
  - Every 15 Minutes- Jennifer Ambrose: 11/6 and 11/7. This program exposes 11th and 12th graders to a simulation of a deadly accident. Participating students will go through a powerful experience as if they have died in an alcohol-related crash. An assembly with parent speakers will be given to all 11th and 12th graders.
  - California Voting Rights Act- Sal Frias: This new proposal creates specific territories assigned to designated School Board Representatives. Voters would have to vote in their designated area for that Board Member. Meetings giving information about this new procedure will be in the near future.
