NSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIAL MEDICAL TREATMENT (Please identify for whom these instructions apply):					

This dance is a school-sponsored activity and <u>all</u> school rules and regulations will be in effect.

In particular, your attention is called to the Wm. S. Hart Union High School District's policy on possession/use/influence of alcohol, drugs or any controlled substances. Stated simply:

Any student who has unlawfully possessed, used, sold or otherwise furnished or been under the influence of any controlled substance as defined in Section 11032 of the Health and Safety Code, alcoholic beverage or intoxicant of any kind at school or any school sponsored activity shall be subject to:

- 1. An immediate five (5) day out-of-school suspension;
- 2. Possible arrest by law enforcement authorities;
- 3. Possible expulsion from all schools in the District;
- 4. Possible transfer to another school or educational program;
- 5. Possible denial of the privilege of participation in graduation ceremonies and/or extracurricular activities.

SCHOOL APPRORIATE ATTIRE is REQUIRED for boys and girls. All dress code policies remain in effect. No bare midriffs or inappropriate, revealing dresses will be allowed. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE DANCE IF THEY ARE INAPPROPRIATELY DRESSED. This includes, but is not limited to, exaggerated or plunging necklines, bare midriff, see-through materials, and short hemlines. **No refunds will be issued for students removed for dress code violations.**

Students and their guests are expected to BEHAVE APPROPRIATELY on the dance floor. Any students or guests who engage in dangerous, lewd, or inappropriate behavior on the dance floor, including "freak dancing" and/or "twerking" that may be interpreted as being sexually suggestive, will be removed from the dance floor. No refunds will be issued for students violating dance floor expectations.
