Qualifications for CSF membership each semester are:

- You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.
 The first 4 points must be from List 1. (unless you are a Senior Feb or May application, then they can come 1&2)
 At least 7 points must be from Lists 1 and 2 (or all points may be from List 1).
 The remaining points may come from List 1, 2, or 3.
 (Seniors applying using Sr. Fall or Spring grades may use 3 courses from List 2 if no List 1 courses were taken).
- No CSF points are given for PE, repeated courses, TA, office aide or pass/fail courses.
- No "D," or "F," grades in any subject.
- CSF points are granted based on grades on GPA

The point scale is: Regular classes

- A = 3 points
- B = 1 point
- C = 0 points

AP/Honors (2 classes only)

- A = 4 points
- B = 2 points
- C = 0 points

One additional point is granted for a grade of **A** or **B** in an AP or Honors course. **Maximum of two points per semester**

- "D" or an "F" in ANY subject disqualifies you for that semester. Membership is based on work done in the previous semester.
- Use no more than five (5) courses to qualify.
- Summer school, on-line or college courses do not apply. Please see Advisor if you have a question
