RE: AP Sales begin January 16th

It is now time to purchase the AP exams that will be administered in May. This year, AP exams can <u>only</u> be purchased online (SAME AS LAST YEAR). Each AP Exam will cost \$94. There will also be a \$4 administration fee charged per student. To purchase your exams, please go to:

The window to purchase your exams is open through **February 8th**. If you miss this regular registration deadline, you may still purchase your exam until 3 pm on Thursday, February 14th but you will be charged an additional \$10. To summarize, if you miss the February 8th deadline, you will have until February 14th to complete your purchase, but each exam will now be \$104. Please be aware that after February 14th, there will be no refunds for any reason, so I encourage you to very carefully consider which exams you will be able to commit to taking. After February 14th at 3 pm, the purchasing window will close. You are STRONGLY advised NOT to wait until the last minute to buy your exams. Technical difficulties or other issues will not be excused. Please plan to purchase your tests as soon as possible to give yourself ample time to work through any difficulties.

****If you registered for AP exams last year, you will use the SAME email address this year. All your info is saved. ^(C) At the bottom of the main page, it says "Have you previously registered? Login Here"

A few of you have two tests that will be administered at the same time. Please see me before February 1st to discuss alternate testing. If you would like to take an exam but it conflicts with a schoolsponsored event, I need to know this before February 1st as well. Choosing after the 1st to take a test at an alternate time for any reason other than a previously school sponsored event or concurrent exams will result in students paying for the original test, a late test, and a \$45 late fee. You can qualify to pay a reduced fee if you participate in the free/reduced lunch program or qualify based on your parent's income. If you would like to qualify for the reduced fee, there will paperwork and steps to complete as part of your online registration. Because this extra step will take time, if you would like to apply for the reduced fee, <u>please complete your</u> <u>registration no later than January 29th</u>. Also, please be aware that all late fees will apply.

Below are the dates and times for each AP Exam. Be advised that doors close at 7:40 for the morning tests and 12:30 for the afternoon test. If you are not in your assigned seat and ready to test by the time the doors close you will not be able to test and there are no refunds given.
