*Sal Frias reported that small on campus cohorts will return for 2nd Semester. Parents can request to have their student placed in a cohort by completing the online form found on our website. Last semester had over 200 interested students: 55% of students showed improvement in grades, 34 % stayed the same, and 11 % declined.

*Sal Frias reported that the new bell schedule can be found on our website with an alternating block schedule of 3 periods each day. MAP will start after the lunch period. Athletic conditioning will start after school on 2/1/21.

* Sal Frias reported that the Equity and Diversity committee is looking for new students to join.

*Sal Frias discussed the possibility of using Finals week for testing and assessments.

*Nicolette Smith reported that the next ELAC meeting will be on 1/28/21 and they are presently working on student assessments.

*Ann McCann reported that textbook distribution will take place over 4 days during after school hours. Students are able to check out new e-books and hardcover books. Library pop up is a new idea that provides a fast and easy way to request books.
