The Cafeteria is continuing to happily offer each student one free breakfast, and one free lunch to each student every day.

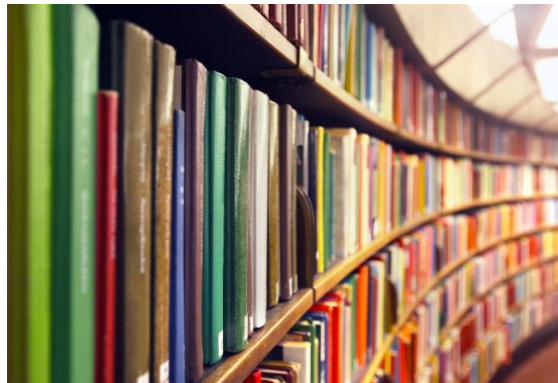

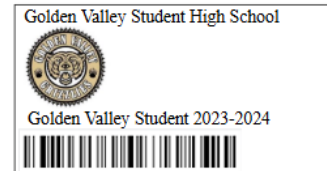

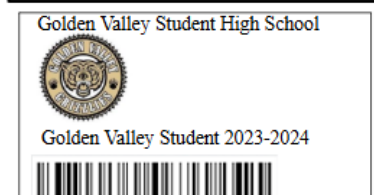

Please follow the below steps to make an appointment.

STEP 1: Secure Employment

Students need to secure a job before obtaining a work permit.

STEP 2: Download the Work Permit Application

STEP 3: Complete the Work Permit Application:

Students are to complete the sections “Minor’s Information” and “School Information.”

1. Students are to complete the sections “Minor’s Information” and “School Information.”
2. Employers are to complete the section “For Employer to Complete” then print and sign their name.
3. Parents/guardians are required to sign the form for knowledge and consent.

STEP 4: Request an Appointment

Email workpermit@hartdistrict.org to request a work permit. An auto-reply will provide appointment instructions.

New Football Game Guidelines

To ensure the safety of our students and families, we have implemented new guidelines for our football games:

1. **No Backpacks Allowed:** Students are not permitted to bring backpacks to the games. Please leave them at home or in your vehicle.
2. **Canteen/lower parking lot area Closing:** The canteen area will close 2 minutes prior to the end of the fourth quarter. Be sure to grab any snacks or drinks before this time.
3. **Athlete/Guardian Pick-Up:** Guardians will meet their athletes in the parking lot after the game. Please make your way there to connect with your child.
4. Spectators/families are not permitted to be on the field before, during, or after the game.
5. **Loss Of Privilege (LOP):** Students who are on LOP are not able to attend extra-curricular activities including athletic events, rallies, and dances.
6. Students are required to show their ID card at ALL school events.

GV Administration reserves the right to deny entry and remove individuals for prior conduct or conduct occurring during the contest.
