Please follow the below steps to make an appointment.

STEP 1: Secure Employment

Students need to secure a job before obtaining a work permit.

<u>STEP 2</u>: Download the Work Permit Application Click on the following link to download:

STATEMENT OF INTENT TO EMPLOY A MINOR AND REQUEST FOR A WORK PERMIT–CERTIFICATE OF AGE CDE Form B1-1 (Rev. 02-14)

STEP 3: Complete the Work Permit Application:

Students are to complete the sections "Minor's Information" and "School Information."

- 1. Students are to complete the sections "Minor's Information" and "School Information."
- 2. Employers are to complete the section "For Employer to Complete" then print and sign their name.
- 3. Parents/guardians are required to sign the form for knowledge and consent.

STEP 4: Request an Appointment

Email workpermit@hartdistrict.org to request a work permit. An auto-reply will provide appointment instructions.

New Football Game Guidelines

- 4. Spectators/families are not permitted to be on the field before, during, or after the game.
- 5. Loss Of Privilege (LOP): Students who are on LOP are not able to attend extra-curricular activities including athletic events, rallies, and dances.
- 6. Students are required to show their ID card at ALL school events.
