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## **Cafeteria News**



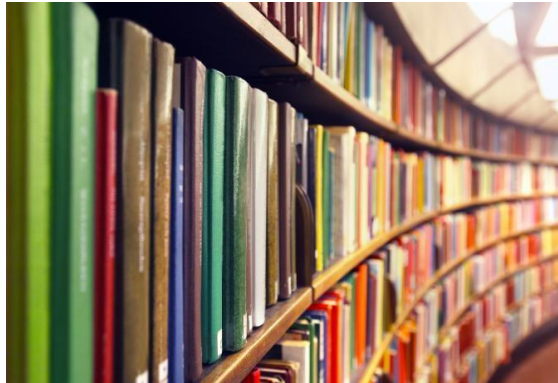
The Cafeteria is continuing to happily offer each student one free breakfast, and one free lunch to each student every day.

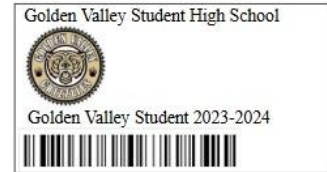

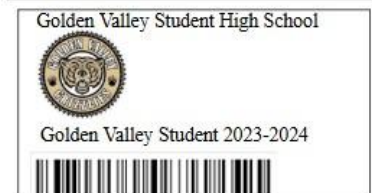

## STEP 1: Secure Employment

Students need to secure a job before obtaining a work permit.

STEP 2: Download the Work Permit Application Click on the following link to download:

**STATEMENT OF INTENT TO EMPLOY A MINOR AND REQUEST FOR A WORK PERMIT–CERTIFICATE OF AGE CDE Form B1-1 (Rev. 02-14)**

## STEP 3: Complete the Work Permit Application:

Students are to complete the sections “Minor’s Information” and “School Information.”

1. Students are to complete the sections “Minor’s Information” and “School Information.”
2. Employers are to complete the section “For Employer to Complete” then print and sign their name.
3. Parents/guardians are required to sign the form for knowledge and consent.

## STEP 4: Request an Appointment

## **New Football Game Guidelines**

4. Spectators/families are not permitted to be on the field before, during, or after the game.
5. **Loss Of Privilege (LOP):** Students who are on LOP are not able to attend extra-curricular activities including athletic events, rallies, and dances.
6. Students are required to show their ID card at ALL school events.

GV Administration reserves the right to deny entry and remove individuals for prior conduct or conduct occurring during the contest.
