Please note there is a replacement fee of \$5.



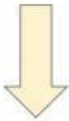
If you have requested a new card or funds to be added on your TAP card and have not received them yet, please stop by the front office. Please remember all requests take at least 2 days to process.

Please follow the below steps to make an appointment.

STEP 1: Secure Employment

Students need to secure a job before obtaining a work permit.

STEP 2: Get Work Permit Application from
the AP or Front office.

STEP 3: Complete the Work Permit Application:

Students are to complete the sections "Minor's Information" and "School Information."

1. Students are to complete the sections "Minor's Information" and "School Information."
2. Employers are to complete the section "For Employer to Complete" then print and sign their name.
3. Parents/guardians are required to sign the form for knowledge and consent.

STEP 4: Bring Application to AP office or Front Office for completion.

### **New Football Game Guidelines**

To ensure the safety of our students and families, we have implemented  
new guidelines for our football games:

1. **No Backpacks Allowed:** Students are not permitted to bring backpacks to the games.

4. Spectators/families are not permitted to be on the field before, during, or after the game.
