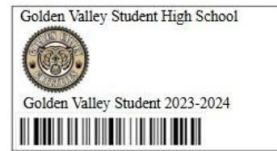

Step 3: Complete the Work Permit Application

Students are to complete the sections "Minor's Information"

1. Student are to complete the sections "Minor's Information and "School Information"
2. Employers are to complete the section "For Employer to Complete" then print and sign their name.
3. Parents/guardians are required to sign the form for knowledge and consent.

New Football Game Guidelines

To ensure the safety of our students and families, we have implemented new guidelines for our football games:

1. **No Backpacks Allowed:** Students are not permitted to bring backpacks to the games. Please leave them at home or in your vehicle
2. **Canteen/lower parking lot area Closing:** The canteen area will close 2 minutes prior to the end of the fourth quarter. Be sure to grab any snacks or drinks before this time.
3. **Athlete/Guardian Pick-Up:** Guardians will meet their athletes in the parking lot after the game. Please make your way there to connect with your child
4. Spectators/families are not permitted to be on the field before, during, or after the game.
5. **Loss Of Privilege (LOP):** Students who are on LOP are not able to attend extra-curricular activities including athletic events, rallies, and dances.
6. Students are required to show their ID card at ALL school events.
