Step 3: Complete the Work Permit Application

Students are to complete the sections "Minor's Information"

- 1. Student are to complete the sections "Minor's Information and "School Information"
- 2. Employers are to complete the section "For Employer to Complete" then print and sign their name.
- 3. Parents/guardians are required to sign the form for knowledge and consent.

Please be sure to complete form in INK

Step 4: Once form is completed, drop it off in the AP office.

It takes 2-3 days to process

New Football Game Guidelines


To ensure the safety of our students and families, we have implemented new guidelines for our football games:

- 1. **No Backpacks Allowed**: Students are not permitted to bring backpacks to the games. Please leave them at home or in your vehicle
- 2. Canteen/lower parking lot area Closing: The canteen area will close 2 minutes prior to the end of the fourth quarter. Be sure to grab any snacks or drinks before this time
- 3. **Athlete/Guardian Pick-Up:** Guardians will meet their athletes in the parking lot after the game. Please make your way there to connect with your child
- 4. Spectators/families are not permitted to be on the field before, during, or after the game.
- 5. **Loss Of Privilege (LOP)**: Students who are on LOP are not able to attend extra-curricular activities including athletic events, rallies, and dances.
- 6. Students are required to show their ID card at ALL school events.
