

Step 3: Complete the Work Permit Application

Students are to complete the sections "Minor's Information"

- 1. Student are to complete the sections "Minor's Information and "School Information"
- 2. Employers are to complete the section "For Employer to Complete" then print and sign their name.
- 3. Parents/guardians are required to sign the form for knowledge and consent.

Please be sure to complete form in INK

Step 4: Once form is completed, drop it off in the AP office.

It takes 2-3 days to process


New Football Game Guidelines

To ensure the safety of our students and families, we have implemented new guidelines for our football games:

- No Backpacks Allowed: Students are not permitted to bring backpacks to the games. Please leave them at home or in your vehicle

- Spectators/families are not permitted to be on the field before, during, or after the game.
- Loss Of Privilege (LOP): Students who are on LOP are not able to attend extra-curricular activities including athletic events, rallies, and dances.
