

### **2020-2021 HS Spring Semester Schedules**

MAP is Mandatory Academic Proficiency: New material will not be introduced and additional assignments will not be made. Teachers will have mandatory sessions for students who are struggling. Intervention, wellness, enrichment, relationship-building, study skills, and re-testing may be provided during MAP. MAP is a mandatory part of the school day. Teachers will notify students required to attend MAP during a specific period. Students who have not demonstrated proficiency or who are missing work will be required to stay for the duration of MAP. Students who received D/F in the class on the prior progress report will be required to attend MAP. All students will have access to this time and the teacher regardless of proficiency. Teachers will create a static Zoom link for each MAP class and it will remain posted in Google Classroom. Teachers may periodically be scheduled to attend a mandatory IEP, SST, or 504 meeting during MAP. The teacher will post, in advance, any MAP periods for which he or she is unavailable.

**WIN:** What I Need time for students. Teachers will have static ZOOM link and be available for students.

### **Teacher Collaboration and Meeting Time:**

Teachers will meet after lunch on Wednesdays to collaborate with colleagues, attend faculty meetings, HDTA meetings, department meetings, and participate in professional development.

#### Continuous Block: A and B Weeks:

Students will attend classes 5 days per week. The block schedule is continuous, so the first week (A) will begin on Monday with periods 2, 3, and 4 and the week will end on Friday with periods 2, 3, and 4. To keep instructional time consistent among all classes, the second week (B) will begin on Monday with periods 5, 6, and 7 and will end on Friday with periods 5, 6, and 7.

#### Holidays:

Any week that begins with a holiday on a Monday will be adjusted to keep the rotation of classes continuous. Schedules will be posted online.

#### Weeks 1 and 2:

The schedule for week 1 beginning January 11, 2021, is unique to allow teachers and students to set up course codes and verify access to the Zoom and Google Classroom. The students will login to every class at the designated time to report for attendance, verify access, meet the teacher and fellow students, and to review course introduction.

The schedule for week 2 beginning January 18, 2021, is unique because Monday is a Martin Luther King holiday and the schedule is shifted by one day.
